Every organisation knows how important cyber-security training is today. According to the UK Government Cyber Security Breaches Survey 2019², over one third of all businesses – and over 60% of large businesses – identified a breach or attack in the past year.

Your staff are your first line of defence and training all staff to recognise and respond to these attacks has never been more important.

But how can you be sure that your training makes any difference to staff behaviour? Will staff even remember what they've heard once they leave the training room?

Our training is different.

By participating in multiple hands-on engagements, your staff will understand, remember and apply the knowledge.

Each session lasts half a day. Each session can have up to 20 people, and we can run 2 sessions in a day.


